Dear Mrs. Prather:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1--12), the Illinois Department of Labor conducted an investigation and audit of the above-referenced contractor's payroll records. The audit revealed that certain employees were paid less than the prevailing rate of wage. The total difference in wages is **\$6,137.85** and is broken down as indicated on the enclosed copy of the audit summary. Accordingly, the Illinois Department of Labor sent the contractor a demand for payment of the back wages to the individuals who were underpaid for their work on the project.

Effective January 1st, 2010, Public Act 96-043, holds public bodies financially responsible for any interest, penalties or fines that would be owed by the contractor when the public body fails to provide proper written notice to a contractor that a project is subject to the Prevailing Wage Act. The Department's investigation revealed that the public body failed to give proper written notice to the contractor that the above-referenced project was subject to the Prevailing Wage Act.

Therefore, IDOL hereby gives notice to **Franklin County Board** that the statutory penalty amount, which represents 20% of the total underpayments made by the contractor, is now due. This amounts to **\$1,227.57**, for the above referenced project and should be paid within 30 days from the date of this notice.

A check should be mailed to the **Prevailing Wage Division, Illinois Department of Labor, 160 N. LaSalle St. Suite C-1300, Chicago, Illinois 60601**, within the next ten (10) business days. It should be made payable to **THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LABOR**. Please list the above-referenced case number on the memo line of the check. Failure to timely submit payment may result in referral to the Attorney General's office for civil enforcement.

If the aforementioned checks for underpayments are not received in the above mentioned office within 30 calendar days of the date of the first demand letter, an additional 2% of the 20% penalty, **\$32.68**, will be assessed on behalf of each of the above mentioned workers, and reassessed after each subsequent 30-day period during which the underpayment for wages has not been received in this office.
