FREE PUBLIC WORKSHOP

The Franklin County Sheriff's office, Southern Illinois Healthcare, Franklin/Williamson Healthy Communities Coalition and the Village of West City have partnered with the Extreme Exigency Educational Foundation to sponsor two personal safety workshops at the West City Community Center 201 S. Browning Street in West City, Illinois. The workshops will be held on Thursday August 13th, 2015 and will run from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm and 6:00pm to 8:00 pm.

Predators have invaded our neighborhoods, schools, stores, workplace and our places of worship and predators don't play by the rules. These workshops developed and delivered by 30 year retired veteran law enforcement officer Ray Minor are unlike any other victim awareness or prevention program. The workshops differ because they build on safety for ourselves first, so we can keep others safe, understanding when we are vulnerable, recognizing intuition, warning signals and how predators work in all areas of our lives. Other topics include, home invasions, physical attacks, armed robbery, active shooters and closing with protecting our children. It's like learning how to predict predators' behavior, and predict violence by knowing their plays and how to recognize them.

The law enforcement community has long known the elements needed for violence or victimization to take place. However, knowing the causes of violence does little to do with predicting or the prevention of violence before it happens. The Predator's Playbook workshops will provide participants with these skills. It's like reading the predator play book and predicting their next move or the predator's next plays.

The workshops are for anyone desiring greater personal safety and are strongly encouraged for anyone involved in security for their schools, place of worship, or business.
