WHEREAS, the County Board of Franklin County has adopted a resolution establishing the salary of the County Engineer to be 100% of the recommended salary for the County Engineer as determined annually by the Illinois Department of Transportation, and percentage

WHEREAS, the County Board of Franklin County has entered into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation for transfer of Federal Surface Transportation Program funds to pay one-half of the salary paid to the County Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Franklin County Board that there is hereby appropriated the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$110,400.00) from the County's

County Highway funds for the purpose of paying the County Engineer's salary from 12/1/19 to 11/30/20 and, Fund beginning date ending date

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Franklin County Board hereby authorizes the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois to transfer Fifty Five Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars

(\$55,200.00) of Federal Surface Transportation Program funds allocated to Franklin County to the Department of Transportation in return for an equal amount of State funds; and County

The resolution authorizing the transfer of \$55,200.00 of Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds for partial reimbursement of the Franklin County Engineer's salary was approved by the department on January 15, 2020. A copy of the approved resolution is attached.

A warrant in the amount of the STP transfer will be issued to the County Treasurer and mailed to you by the State Comptroller's office in the near future. This warrant should be deposited in the county's Motor Fuel Tax account. We have assigned a section designation of 20-CS055-00-AC for use in monitoring the fund transfer. The section designation identifies the year "20" of the transfer, the "CS" indicates the transfer is for County Engineer's salary, "055" is your county number, and the "AC" identifies it as credit to the county's Motor Fuel Tax account.

For your reference, the agreement between the County and IDOT for participation in the salary program was executed on January 4, 2017 and expires on January 3, 2023.
