Franklin County Sheriff, Don Jones reported 122 inmates currently in the County Jail.

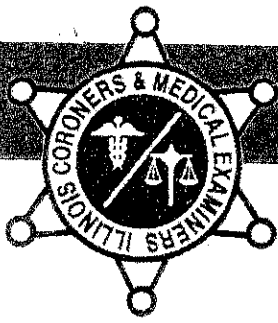
