

**FRANKLIN COUNTY JAIL FACILITY  
VISITATION RULES**

- 1) Inmates are allowed two visits per week. At no time will more than three visitors be allowed to visit you at one time. A visit may consist of:
  - A) Three adults at the same time
  - B) Two adults and one juvenile at the same time, or
  - C) One adult and two juveniles at the same time
- 2) A visit shall consist of 15 minutes of time per visit, per inmate, per visiting group and No physical contact will be allowed unless court ordered.
- 3) Wednesday is considered the first visiting day of the visitation week. Visiting days are Wednesday 6:30pm to 9pm, Sunday 1pm to 4pm. Visits will be on a first come first serve basis and the last visiting group will be allowed in at 8:45pm on Wednesday and 3:45pm on Sunday.
- 4) Photo identification will be required before entering visitation area
- 5) While in visitation you will be expected to comply with the following rules:
  - A) No food or drinks allowed
  - B) You are not allowed to sit or stand on the visiting tables
  - C) Disrobing is strictly prohibited
  - D) You must conduct your visit in a manner as to not disturb other visitors, example, loud talking or yelling
- 6) Failure to comply with above mentioned rules will result in the suspension of your visiting privileges.
- 7) Books, magazines, letters, pictures, etc. will not be released or received during visitation.
- 8) It is your responsibility to coordinate your visits with your family and friends. If someone comes to visit you and you have had your allotted visits for the week, they will be denied.
- 9) No visitor under the age of 12 years will be allowed in without approval by the senior officer on duty or the jail supervisor.
