# AGREEMENT NO. 2014-17

Franklin County Hiring Policy  
Passed by Franklin County Board July 22, 2014

The county believes that hiring qualified individuals is an overall obligation to the taxpayers and citizens of Franklin County. The county will check an applicant's background, including any pertinent criminal record as a part of the hiring process. The search may include any appropriate, reliable criminal offender record information. In seeking any necessary information (through the use of fingerprints or any other method), the following practice and procedures should be followed:


1. A criminal history verification will be conducted by the county on the recommended candidate for hire, prior to making a final offer of employment.
2. The candidate will be provided a copy of the criminal history report, informed of any findings of concern, and given the opportunity to verify and respond to them.
3. The criminal record checks will be conducted in accordance with applicable law, and applicant would be required to complete a Disclosure Authorization form.
4. All fingerprinting will be accomplished through the office of the Franklin County Sheriff.
5. Only criminal convictions will be considered when making employment decisions. Criminal conviction does not necessarily preclude employment with the county. When evaluating this information, the following will be considered:
  - The nature and gravity of the offense
  - The amount of time that has passed since the conviction and/or completion of the sentence
  - Evidence of rehabilitation
  - The nature of the job in question
6. Reasonable caution will be exercised when interpreting evaluative information to insure that discrimination does not occur.

This policy does not replace any specific background verification process already in place by the county. The county office that receives the background and criminal history information shall keep such information confidential and it will be provided on a strict need-to-know basis. Any discussions must be pertinent to a hiring process.

If the record contains convictions, the Franklin County Elected/Appointed Officers of the office involved in hiring will evaluate the record on the basis of this policy. The candidate will be contacted and will be provided with a copy of the criminal history report. The candidate will then be given the opportunity to meet personally with the Elected/Appointed Officers and respond to the criminal history report.
