WHEREAS, the County Board of Franklin County has adopted a resolution establishing the salary of the County Engineer to be \$102,100 (100%) percent of the recommended salary for the County Engineer as determined annually by the Illinois Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Franklin County has entered into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation for transfer of federal funds to pay one-half of the salary paid to the County Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Franklin County Board that there is hereby appropriated, the sum of one hundred and two thousand and one hundred dollars (\$102,100) from the County's Highway and Motor Fuel Fund funds for the purpose of paying the County Engineer's salary from 12/1/2014 to 11/30/2015, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Franklin County Board hereby authorizes the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois, to transfer fifty one thousand and fifty dollars (\$51,050) of Federal Surface Transportation Program Funds allocated to Franklin County to the Department of Transportation in return for an equal amount of State funds.

**FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-06**  
**AN ORDINANCE IN REGARD TO THE SALE OF FOOD**  
**PRODUCTS BY HOME KITCHEN OPERATIONS**

Whereas, the State of Illinois has enacted 410 ILCS 625/3.4, which amends the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act (410 ILCS 625/1 et seq.) by establishing and defining a new type of food service operations known as “Home Kitchen Operation”; and

Whereas, it is the intention of 410 ILCS 625/3.4 (the “Cupcake Law”) to allow for the limited sale of certain food products made in the home to the general public with less regulatory oversight than customary commercial food products; and

Whereas, the “Cupcake Law” provides that it will take effect only in those counties or municipalities that have adopted an ordinance authorizing the direct sale of certain baked goods, that are not potentially hazardous baked food as defined in Section 4 of the Food Handling Regulation and Enforcement Act (410 ILCS 625/4);

Whereas, the Franklin County Board supports the policies and objectives of the Illinois Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, as well as “the Cupcake Law”, as defined in therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND DECREED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

**Food Handling Regulation and Enforcement Act and Home Kitchen Food Operations in  
Franklin County, Illinois**

(A) The Franklin County Board hereby adopts and incorporates the provisions of the Illinois Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act (410 ILCS 625/1 et seq.), as amended.

(B) Home Kitchen Operations, as defined by the Illinois Food Handling and Enforcement Act, as amended, are permitted within Franklin County, provided all requirements of the Illinois Food Handling Regulation and Enforcement Act and other provisions of this ordinance are complied with by the producers and sellers of said products.

(C) Home Kitchen Operations which propose to produce any non-potentially hazardous foods for sale, as defined by the Illinois Food Handling and Enforcement Act, shall be registered with the Franklin-Williamson Bi-County Health Department; shall meet the requirements of Franklin Williamson Bi-County Health Department for training in the safe handling of food products for Home Kitchens; and shall comply with all regulations and guidelines for the safe handling of food. Monthly gross sales from any Home Kitchen Operation may not exceed \$1,000.00. A written notice shall be provided to each purchaser as follows:

*‘This product was produced in a home kitchen not subject to public health inspection and may also possess common food allergens’*


(D) The Franklin-Williamson Bi-County Health Department is appointed by the Franklin County Board to oversee the operations of Home Kitchen Operations as defined herein and to adopt procedures for the registration, training, and operation of Home Kitchens in Franklin County. The Franklin-Williamson Bi-County shall inspect any Home Kitchen Operation in the event of a complaint or disease outbreak and may, at Franklin-Williamson Bi-County Health Department's discretion, issue binding orders upon any Home Kitchen Operation to: comply with safe food handling requirements; modify home kitchen practices; suspend or terminate the home kitchen operation; as deemed to be in the public health and welfare.


(E) The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. The invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not be construed to invalidate the remainder.

(F) Any Ordinance in direct, express conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

(G) This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

**RESOLUTION AMENDING**

**CIRCUIT CLERK'S AUTOMATION FUND FEE**

**WHEREAS**, 705 ILCS 105/27.3a, amended June 1, 2014, authorizes the County Board to approve and enact a resolution establishing a fee of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$25.00 to be charged and collected by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in order to defray the expense of establishing and maintaining an automated record keeping system in the Circuit Clerk's office, and

**WHEREAS**, such fee is to be paid at the time of filing the first pleading, paper or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases, and

**WHEREAS**, on September 17, 2013, the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois, elected to establish an automated record keeping system in the office of the Franklin County Circuit Clerk and approved an automation fee of \$15.00 to be collected by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, in order to defray the expense of establishing such a system pursuant to 705 ILCS 105/27.3a,

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois finds that the increased cost of maintaining the automated record keeping system of the Circuit Clerk requires that the Circuit Clerk's Automation Fund Fee in civil cases be increased to \$25.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois that pursuant to 705 ILCS 105/27.3a, amended June 1, 2014, the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Franklin County, Illinois, shall charge and collect a Circuit Clerk's Automation Fund Fee in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the first pleading, paper or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases. This Circuit Clerk's Automation Fund Fee shall be in addition to any other fees and costs assessed by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, in these cases. In addition, no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is presented in a single pleading, paper or other appearance. Such fee shall be collected in the manner in which all other fees or costs are collected.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all automation fees collected by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, shall be deposited in a special fund known as the " Circuit Clerk's Automation Fund" and such funds accumulated by this fee will be expended only for the purpose of automating the record keeping system of the Franklin County Circuit Clerk.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Clerk of Franklin County , Illinois, shall file a certified copy of this resolution in the office of the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, as written notice that the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois, has approved and acted to amend the Circuit Clerk's Automation Fund Fee in civil cases to \$25.00. The Circuit Clerk shall amend and commence such charges and collections upon receipt of this written notice and certified copy of this resolution. The Franklin County Circuit Clerk shall file and maintain a certified copy of this resolution in her office.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that said fund shall be audited by the county auditor, and the board shall make expenditure from the fund in payment of any cost related to the automation of the court records, including hardware, software, research and development costs and personnel related thereto, provided that the expenditure is approved by the Franklin County Circuit Clerk and by the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court or his designate.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the resolution establishing the Circuit Clerk's Automation Fee which became effective September 17, 2013 is hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that such fees shall not be charged in any matter coming to any such clerk on change of venue, nor in any proceeding to review the decision of any administrative officer, agency or body.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall become effective December 1, 2014, and shall remain in effect until modified by the Franklin County Board.

**RESOLUTION AMENDING**

**CIRCUIT CLERK'S COURT DOCUMENT STORAGE FUND FEE**

**WHEREAS**, 705 ILCS 105/27.3a, amended June 1, 2014, authorizes the County Board to approve and enact a resolution establishing a fee of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$25.00 to be charged and collected by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in order to defray the expense of establishing and maintaining a court document storage fund in the Circuit Clerk's office, and

**WHEREAS**, such fee is to be paid at the time of filing the first pleading, paper or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases, and

**WHEREAS**, on September 17, 2013, the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois, elected to establish a court document storage fund in the office of the Franklin County Circuit Clerk and approved a court document storage fund fee of \$15.00 to be collected by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, in order to defray the expense of establishing such a system pursuant to 705 ILCS 105/27.3a,

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois finds that the increased cost of maintaining the court document storage fund of the Circuit Clerk requires that the Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund Fee in civil cases be increased to \$25.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois that pursuant to 705 ILCS 105/27.3a, amended June 1, 2014, the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Franklin County, Illinois, shall charge and collect a Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund Fee in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the first pleading, paper or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases. This Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund Fee shall be in addition to any other fees and costs assessed by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, in these cases. In addition, no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is presented in a single pleading, paper or other appearance. Such fee shall be collected in the manner in which all other fees or costs are collected.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all court document storage fees collected by the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, shall be deposited in a special fund known as the " Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund" and such funds accumulated by this fee will be expended only for the purpose of court document storage of the Franklin County Circuit Clerk.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, shall file a certified copy of this resolution in the office of the Circuit Clerk of Franklin County, Illinois, as written notice that the County Board of Franklin County, Illinois, has approved and acted to amend the Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund Fee in civil cases to \$25.00. The Circuit Clerk shall amend and commence such charges and collections upon receipt of this written notice and certified copy of this resolution. The Franklin County Circuit Clerk shall file and maintain a certified copy of this resolution in her office.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that said fund shall be audited by the county auditor, and the board shall make expenditure from the fund in payment of any cost related to the court document storage of the court records, including hardware, software, research and development costs and personnel related thereto, provided that the expenditure is approved by the Franklin County Circuit Clerk and by the Chief Judge of the Circuit Court or his designate.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the resolution establishing the Circuit Clerk's Court Document Storage Fund Fee which became effective September 17, 2013 is hereby repealed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that such fees shall not be charged in any matter coming to any such clerk on change of venue, nor in any proceeding to review the decision of any administrative officer, agency or body.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall become effective December 1, 2014, and shall remain in effect until modified by the Franklin County Board.





Be it resolved by the Franklin County Board of Franklin County, Illinois as follows:


