Public notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article 19A of the Illinois Election Code, that Early Voting in Franklin County will be conducted on the following dates and location prior to the November 6, 2018 General Election:

The Franklin County Election Office, Campbell Building, 901 Public Square, Benton, IL will be open Monday thru Saturday 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. beginning October 13, 2018 thru November 5, 2018. The Office will be open **Monday, November 5, 2018 until 5:00 P.M. for absentee voting.**

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING INFORMATION

Early Voting allows all registered voters to cast their ballot prior to Election Day between Monday, October 1, 2018 and Monday, November 5, 2018 by voting at the **FRANKLIN COUNTY ELECTION OFFICE ONLY**. Early Voters must be registered voters with a valid picture ID showing their current voter registration address. No excuse or reason is necessary to take advantage of Early Voting. Any vote cast during the Early Voting period is final and may not be revoked. Early Voters are not eligible to vote on Election Day.

Absentee voting will be conducted at the County Election Office or by mail. No excuse is necessary for absentee voting. In person absentee voting will start Monday, October 1, 2018 and ends Monday, November 5, 2018 at 5:00 P.M. The last day to apply for a mailed absentee ballot is Thursday, November 1, 2018.
