

GRACE PERIOD VOTING DATES

Public notice is hereby given, pursuant to ILCS 5/4-50 of the Illinois Election Code, that Grace Period Voting in Franklin County will be conducted on the following dates and location prior to the November 6, 2018 General Election. Grace Period registration is not new, but the deadline is new. A new state law extends the deadline thru Election Day.

GRACE PERIOD VOTING INFORMATION

Grace Period voting allows people who have never registered or failed to change their address or voting information to make these changes after the normal deadline, which was on October 9, 2018. Grace period was first established for the 2006 election, Grace Period voters must register or update their information **ONLY** in the County Clerk's Election Office. The voter must then cast their ballot at this time. This window takes place only between October 10, 2018 and November 6, 2018 for the General Election. A Grace Period registrant may **not** vote in the polling place on Election Day.
