Randall Crocker reported the Franklin Hospital had recently purchased additional buildings and property tax exemptions were discussed.

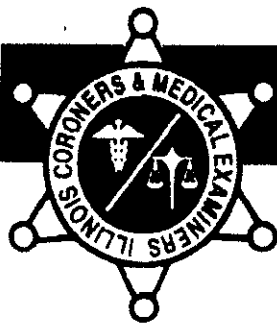
Tom Vaughn reported on the Tourism Council and Economic Development concerning the Bombardier building, discussion followed.
