**ORDINANCE INCREASING FEE FOR
INMATE PROCESSING OR CRIMINAL BOND PROCESSING INCURRED BY THE
FRANKLIN COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO 55 ILCS 5/4-5001**

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/4-5001, defines Franklin County as a county of the second class; and sets the amount of fees to be collected by the Sheriff in counties of the second class; and

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/4-5001 allows a county board to increase such fees to an amount sufficient to cover the cost of providing such services; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff has reported that the costs of processing inmates and taking criminal bond continue to increase and that the current fee of \$20 per inmate, set in Ordinance #2011-08, is insufficient to cover the costs of inmate processing;


WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board has authorized a cost study to be performed to evaluate the current costs of processing inmate at the Franklin County Jail in accordance with 55 ILCS 5/5-5001 and said study has been performed by Hudgens and Meyer LLC, Certified Public Accountants and justifies increasing inmate processing fees up to \$29.72.


WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board has reviewed the cost study, which is part of the county records, and has determined that an increase in inmate processing fees from the current rate of \$20.00 per inmate to \$29.00 per inmate is necessary to generate sufficient revenues to provide for the costs of inmate processing services or the taking of criminal bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND DECREED, by the Franklin County Board as follows:

1. That beginning July 1, 2019, the inmate processing fee charged to all inmates of the Franklin County Jail shall be \$29.00 per booking.
2. That this Ordinance repeals and replaces all resolutions or ordinances that are in conflict including, but not limited to, Ordinance #2011-08.
3. That in the event any provision of this ordinance shall be found to be invalid by ruling of a judicial authority, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
