# AMENDMENT TO FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 1995-4 (LC-3-1)

# REGARDING HOURS OF OPERATION NO. 2020- 03

#### I. Preamble:

Whereas, Franklin County currently has a Liquor Ordinance in effect which does not allow for liquor to be sold by places holding Class "A" and Class "B" liquor licenses from 1:00 a.m. on Sundays until 7:00 a.m. on Mondays.

Whereas, The Franklin County Board determines that this puts businesses selling liquor in the unincorporated areas of the county at a disadvantage to their competing businesses in local municipalities that are allowed to sell liquor on Sundays.

Whereas, The Franklin County Board desires to amend the County Liquor Ordinance to allow businesses with a Class "A" or Class "B" liquor license to sell liquor on Sundays;

## II. Enactment:

The Franklin County Board does hereby ordain, adopt, and decree as follows:

A. That Article III – Regulations of the Franklin County Liquor Code, 1995-4, paragraph LC-3-1 (B) and (E) are amended as follows:

## LC-3-1 HOURS

- (B) All places operating under a Class "A" or Class "B" license shall close at 1:00 a.m Sunday and remain closed until 12:00 noon Sunday; and must again close at 11:00 p.m. Sunday until 7:00 a.m. the following Monday. All other days of the week said Class "A" or Class "B" licenses shall close at 1:00 a.m. and remain closed until 7:00 a.m.
- (E) When December 31<sup>st</sup> falls on a Sunday all classes of licenses, other than Class "F", may open and sell and dispense alcoholic liquors on said day from 12:00 noon on December 31<sup>st</sup> until 1:00 a.m. on January 1<sup>st</sup>.

This Amendment to Ordinance 1995-4 shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
