MINUTES OF MEETING Oct 29, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

The Speical Meeting of the County Board, was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairman Randall Crocker. COURTHOUSE FOUNDATION PLAN

Chairman Randall Crocker stated that the purpose of this special meeting is to discuss and decide on a plan for the Courthouse Foundation. Chairman Randall Crocker introduced Joe Sweitzer from Navigate Building Solutions and turned the meeting over to him. Joe Sweitzer explained he sent out information to board members on the foundation system that is being proposed. There are three options for the County Board to chose from - Option 1: Drilled Piers with a cost of \$227,348.29. Option 2: Over Excavation with a cost of \$142,629.20. Option 3: Widen Shallow Footings with a cost of \$153,188.80. All with some addition cost to the County. All have additional worked days

added the length of the estimated time to build the courthouse. The County Board discussed and agreed on Option 1: Drilled Piers at a cost of \$227,348.29 with an additional cost for material testing.

Larry Miller made a motion for Option 1: Drilled Piers at a cost of \$227,348.29. Alan Price seconded the motion. On roll call vote, all voted yes.
