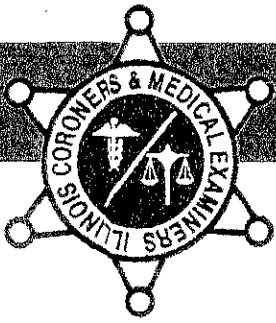
Randall Crocker discussed agenda items for the regular September meeting, including appointments.
