Franklin County Coroner, Marty Leffler, submitted and explained his monthly report, a copy of said report is hereby attached as a part of these minutes, discussion followed.

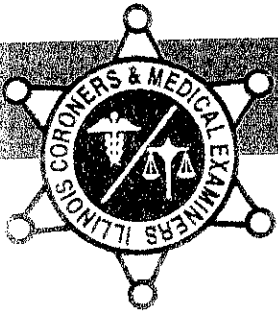
Franklin County Sheriff, Don Jones reported new Healthcare at the Franklin County Jail.
