

Amendment to Franklin County Liquor Ordinance 1995-4

WHEREAS it is a goal of the County Board of Franklin County to promote commerce in the County; and

WHEREAS the Alcoholic Beverage industry has, in recent years, proven to be a successful economic venture in other areas; and


WHEREAS it is the desire of the Franklin County Board to encourage such ventures while fulfilling its statutory duty of regulation;

THEREFORE, The County of Franklin hereby amends Franklin County Liquor Ordinance 1995-4 as follows:

LC 2-8 LICENSE CLASSIFICATION, FEES LIMITATION

(A) **Class "A" License**, which shall entitle the licensee to sell alcoholic liquors of all kinds in the place named therein, by the drink to be consumed on the premises, as well as in unbroken original packages as defined in this Code, and not to be consumed on the premises, but not for resale. The annual fee for such license shall be One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000). There shall not be more than nine (9) Class "A" Licenses in effect at one time.
