The Public Safety Meeting was called to order at 5:48 PM by Chairman John Gossett. See above list of those attending.

Marty Leffler, Franklin County Coroner, gave an update on a recent Covid incident and expressed his opinion on the importance of vaccinations and booster shots.

Chairman Gossett updated the board on the latest actions by the US Supreme Court blocking the vaccine-or-test rule (COVID-19) for US businesses. This would take items 12-15 off the following board meeting agenda. He also noted that mandates are not laws

South Central Transit (SCT) representatives John Schubert and Sara Nollman-Hodge explained transportation services and schedules provided through SCT. (See Public Safety Attachment 1) They also gave a 5+ year ridership list (See Public Safety Attachment 2) by county. Before Covid-19, Franklin County was averaging approximately 50,000 per year. In 2020 the amount dropped to 38,872 and in 2021 it was 26,589. For information concerning services, the public can call 800-660-7433. Franklin County's SCT Representative, Pam Boyd, was also present to simply thank the board for allowing her to serve as the representative for the county.

ROE Superintendent Lorie LeQuatte gave her 2nd Quarterly Report for the ROE #21 which will then be accepted by the board during the following board meeting. She did mention that some of her schools were doing an "Adaptive Pause" that will allow time to again sanitize the class rooms. All-in-all schools are doing well.
