**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS**  
**FOR DISSOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY JAIL PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Jail Public Building Commission was created by the County Board Of Franklin pursuant to Resolution 1986-21 Adopted May 20, 1986 under the provisions of Chapter 85, Section 1031, et seq., Illinois revised Statutes 1985 to provide sufficient jail facilities for Franklin County, Illinois, and to build a new jail structure; and

**WHEREAS**, a financial account was established to issue bonds, pay debts and other obligations for the construction and completion of said jail structure, by the Franklin County Jail Public Building Commission ; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Jail Public Building Commission has fulfilled it's purpose and all debts, bonds, and other obligations have been paid in full; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no longer the need for a jail commission to be in existence; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 50 ILCS 20/22.1(b) (from Ch. 85, par. 1052.1) provides as follows:

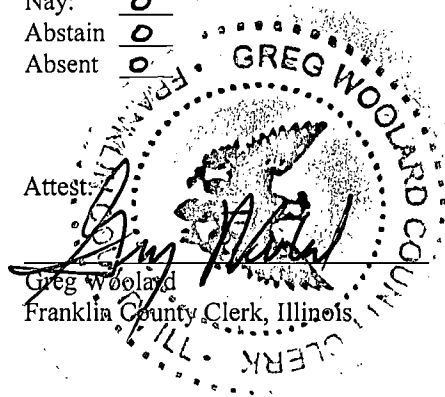
(b) Any Public Building Commission which has fulfilled the purpose for which it was created, and all bonds issued by it and all of its contractual obligations except personnel contracts have been paid, may be dissolved, upon the filing by the presiding officer of the municipality, county seat or county board which organized such Commission, in the office of the recorder, a copy of a resolution adopted by the governing body of such municipality, county seat or county board approving such dissolution. Upon the dissolution of such Commission pursuant to this subsection, the Treasurer of the Commission shall cause all remaining funds under his control to be transferred to the Treasurer of the municipality, county seat or county which organized the Commission.


**WHEREAS**, any remaining proceeds will be transferred to the Franklin County Treasurer and a deed conveying the three (3) parcels of jail real estate will be conveyed vesting title of said real estate to The County of Franklin, Illinois, and upon completion of said transfer of proceeds and conveyance of real estate, and the filing of this Resolution in the office of the recorder of Franklin County, said Franklin County Jail Public Building Commission is hereby dissolved.
