On September 5th, 2024 the Franklin County Sheriff's Office received a report of a domestic violence incident that occurred in rural Buckner. Deputy Mueller, Lt. Uraski, Chief Deputy Roye, and I responded. Supervisor Jason Knowles and TC Tracy King were working in the FCSO Dispatch Center.

Upon arrival to the residence Deputies began speaking with the involved suspect. During conversation, it was observed that the subject was in possession of a handgun. In an attempt to subdue the suspect and affect the arrest, Deputy Mueller deployed his taser. Unfortunately, the taser produced negative results. The suspect immediately produced a pistol and pointed it at deputies. Deputy Uraski recognized the threat and fired a single round from his handgun striking the subject in the midsection and immediately stopping the threat. Deputies immediately took the subject into custody and began to render medical aid.

Franklin County Dispatch was noticed of the officer involved shooting and requested assistance from neighboring agencies as well as EMS. Sheriffs Deputies on scene and Dispatchers Knowles and King working in the Dispatch Center remained calm, professional, and composed throughout the incident.

Their actions are commended for providing great service to the Franklin County Sheriff's Office and the citizens of Franklin County.

I have been reporting to the board for several months that we have been in contact with the US Mashals Service concerning our per diem holding and transport fees. I'm pleased to announce that we have negotiated an increase in the daily holding fee from \$60.00 to \$78.00 per day (+30%). We have also negotiated an increase in the hourly transport fee from \$25.00 to \$35.00 (+40%). As a result, we expect to see a significant increase in those revenues.

This past week the Sheriff's Office also went live on the new digital radio system. This project was initiated by Sheriff Bartoni approximately 2.5 years ago. The system increased our repeater sites from one to three and eliminated poor radio coverage in areas of the county where the previous analog system failed. This was a huge officer safety and public safety project and I thank Sheriff Bartoni and the Board for the support of this project.
