\*The Tek84 Body Scanner equipment is up and running. Staff members have all received formal training from the manufacture. There is a continued learning curve involved in reading the scans but this equipment is a huge asset to the Sheriff's Office and I am thankful for the boards support and financial investment in the safety of correctional staff members.

\*Last week correctional staff administered Narcan to an inmate that was in the booking process. The Narcan had positive results on the detainee. The influx of Fentanyl in our communities and jails continues to be a huge problem. The correctional officers did a great job and acted quickly with poise and confidence in their training.

\*Last week, K9 Riot, was medically retired by the Sheriff's Office. Riot has been on patrol with his handler, Deputy Ryan Payne, since December 2021. Riot developed Dilated Cardiomyopathy, a condition that causes the heart to enlarge and weaken. This condition prevents Riot's ability to tolerate physical exertion. As a result, and at the recommendation of the vet, Riot was retired from service. The initial purchase and training expenses of Riot had been completed by the Southern IL Drug Task Force. Riot will remain in the personal care of Deputy Payne for the remainder of his life.

\*We currently have three juveniles that are in the care of juvenile detention centers. Two are being held in St. Clair County JDC and one is being held in Mississippi County, Missouri. We are paying approximately \$400.00 per day to these facilities for housing. We have \$30,000.00 within our "Juvenile Housing" budget line, however, we are still very early in the budget year. I will closely monitor this line and advise the board should I see a possibility of a significant overage.

\*The Sheriff's Office recently accepted a vehicle donation from Plainfield Police Department. The vehicle is an older model year but has extremely low mileage. The van is equipped with a very expensive inmate transport holding system and will be of great benefit to the sheriff's office for local court transports. The donation also includes (13) Motorola 4E in car video camera systems. We currently use these cameras and pay approximately \$5000.00 each for the units.
