Federal Inmate Holding: I am currently in the process of renegotiating our federal inmate holding contract. We currently charge the US Marshals Service \$60.00 per day for inmate holding. That contract recently became available to reopen, so I am requesting \$85.00 per day, which is more consistent with current rates in our area. The increase in food and labor costs has allowed most jails in our area to renegotiate successfully. I will keep the board informed on this process.

Juvenile Detention Center: There is a scheduled Webex meeting involving numerous upper management staff with the IL Dept of Human Services scheduled for Wednesday. I met today with board members Ray Minor and Kevin Weston to prepare for the meeting and discuss the JDC. I am optimistic and hopeful that IDHS has programming that can utilize the facility. Sheriff's Office staff, Darla Fitzgerald and staff, as well as the ROE have been working to clean out and clean up the facility. Hopefully a site visit can be scheduled later this month with the IDHS.
