Additional bits of Information

SCT has raised their rates once in the past 20 years, in order to keep the fares low so everyone can afford to use our services.

The costs for in town trips and shuttle are \$2.00 or \$.50 per trip. County wide services are more depending on where a person resides in the county. We also have a Client Needs fund that is funded by employee donations and it is used when there is a situation where someone can't afford transportation.

The Chairman of the SCT Board has suggested that all terms end at the end of June, when the 4 year term ends. He suggested this would make it easier for

the counties to keep track of the need to appointment of board members.

However, several of the board members have stated, “if something isn’t broken, let’s not fix it.” The Board meets this Thursday to discuss and vote on the suggestion. Whatever the outcome, the board can only suggest, or request, they have no control on how the counties address the appoint of SCT board members.
