In addition to the foregoing holidays, the Chief Judge may declare a court holiday in any county in the circuit when the court facilities in that county are otherwise closed for the observance of a holiday not listed above. <u>Pursuant to Supreme Court Order M. R. 5272</u>, these additional observances shall be limited to only those situations in which both court security is unavailable, and all county government offices are closed.

In the event the court facilities in a circuit or county are to remain open on one or more of the holidays, the Chief Judge may disregard the listed holiday and declare the court open on that day.

All matters returnable on said legal holidays shall be continued to the next business day of this Court. In addition, the time for filing all motions and pleadings shall be extended to the next business day of this Court.
