

Solid Waste Planning

Under the Illinois Solid Waste and Recycling Act (SWPRA), Illinois counties are required to create a County Solid Waste Plan every five years. These plans are required to include:

- i. *A recycling program*
- ii. *Description of the origin and types of waste generated*
- iii. *Facilities for currently handling waste within the county*
- iv. *Description of programs planned to handle waste over the next 20 years*
- v. *Evaluation of the environmental, energy, life cycle, and economic advantages and disadvantages of the programs*
- vi. *Schedule for implementing the proposals*
- vii. *Potential location for sites necessary to implement the proposals*
- viii. *Identity of the governmental entity responsible for implementation*

Greater Egypt is assisting the five counties with developing their Solid Waste Plans. The process includes conducting a local solid waste and needs assessment, survey of stakeholders, and update to the previous county plan. Planning and meeting information can be found below for each plan.
