Federal Inmate Holding: I am currently in the process of renegotiating our federal inmate holding contract. We currently charge the US Marshals Service \$60.00 per day for inmate holding. That contract recently became available to reopen, so I am requesting \$85.00 per day, which is more consistent with current rates in our area. The increase in food and labor costs has allowed most jails in our area to renegotiate successfully. I will keep the board informed on this process.
