County Highway Engineer Mike Rolla was asked to present county highway's claims to the board and give his report...

- Macedonia Bridge has continued to slow down, less than a quarter of an inch (1/4") in the last two weeks. Coal mines are responsible for cost to bring it back to normal after testing results are finished.
- Again, the possibility of using ARPA funding for replacement of 911 signs was mentioned.
- North Thompsonville Road has a couple of bridges that are showing signs of wear.

Chairman Weston gave his report...

- Reported a leak in the election office – Vaughn Roofing was called.
- Fager-McGee payment #20 will not be processed until all needed information is received.
- Discussed the need for the request for qualification (RFQ) for the proposed morgue.
- Honeywell system had alarms going off at the Court House, but all is ok.
