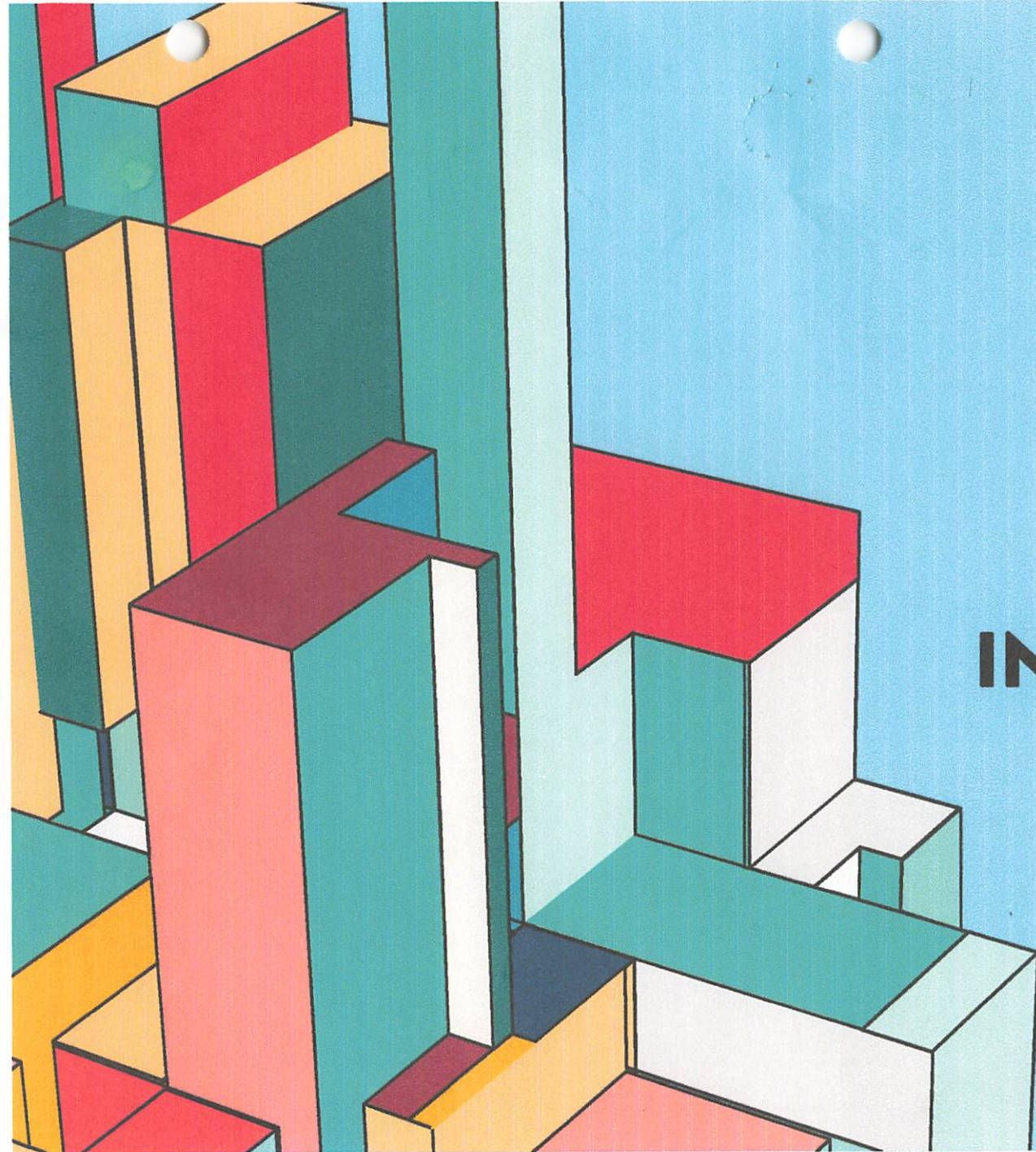
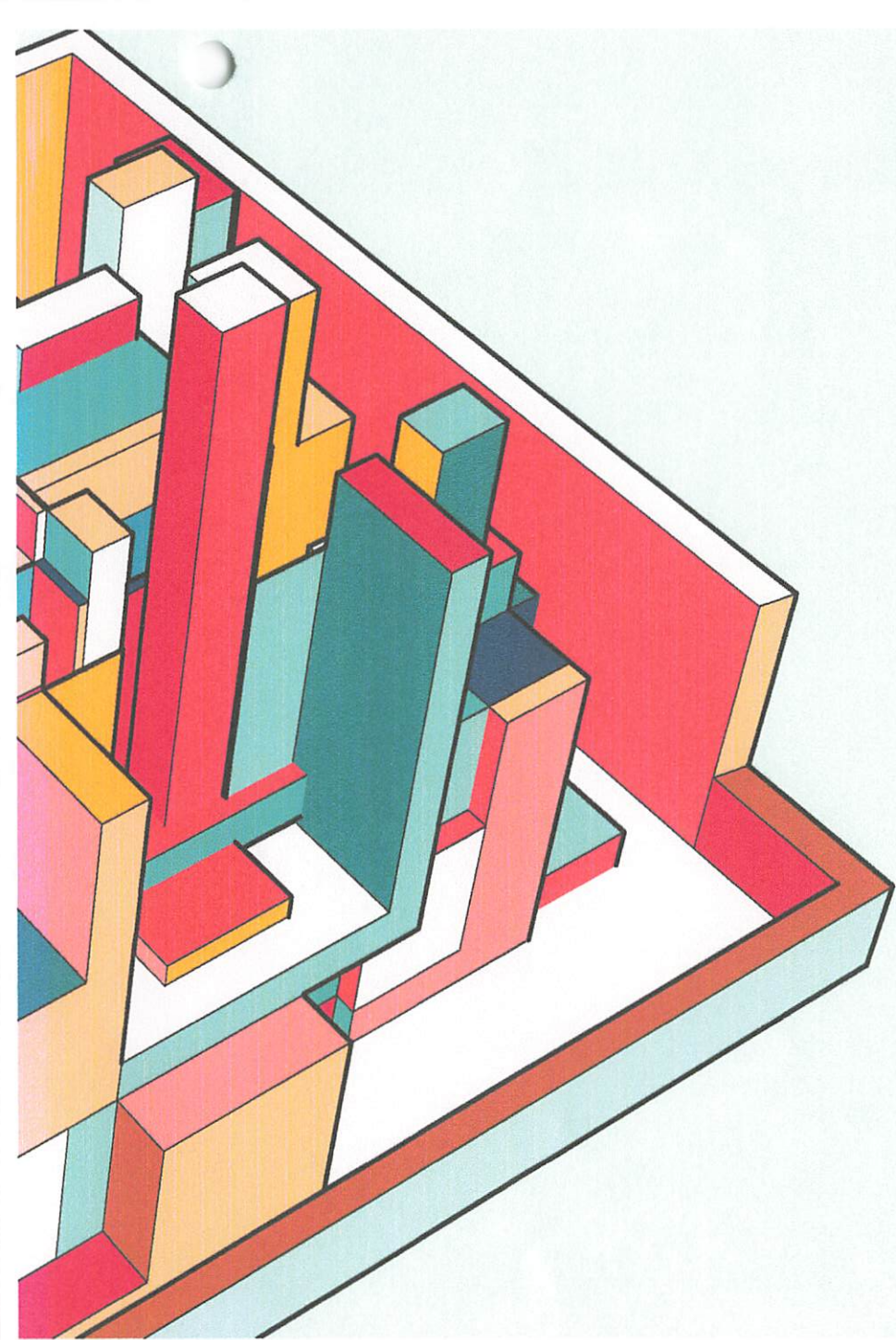

## FACTS FROM THE AMERICAN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ASSOCIATION

- Every \$1 invested in public transportation generates \$5 in economic return.
- Traveling by public transportation is 10 times safer per mile than traveling automobile.
- The average household spends 16 cents of every dollar on transportation, and 93% of this goes to buying, maintaining, and operating cars, the large expenditure after housing.
- A household can save more than \$13,000 by taking public transportation and living with one less car.
- 87% of trips on public transit have a direct impact on the local economy.

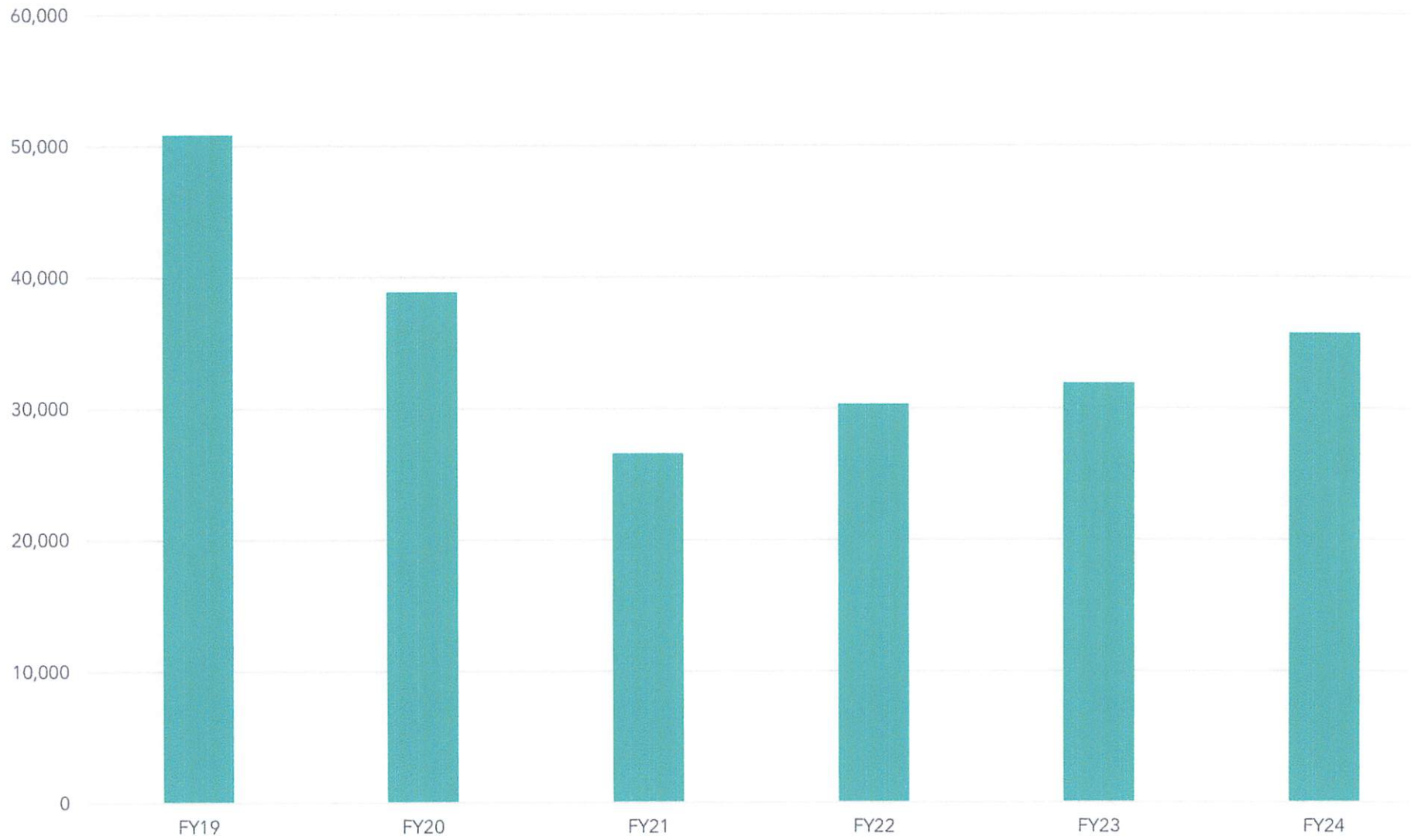

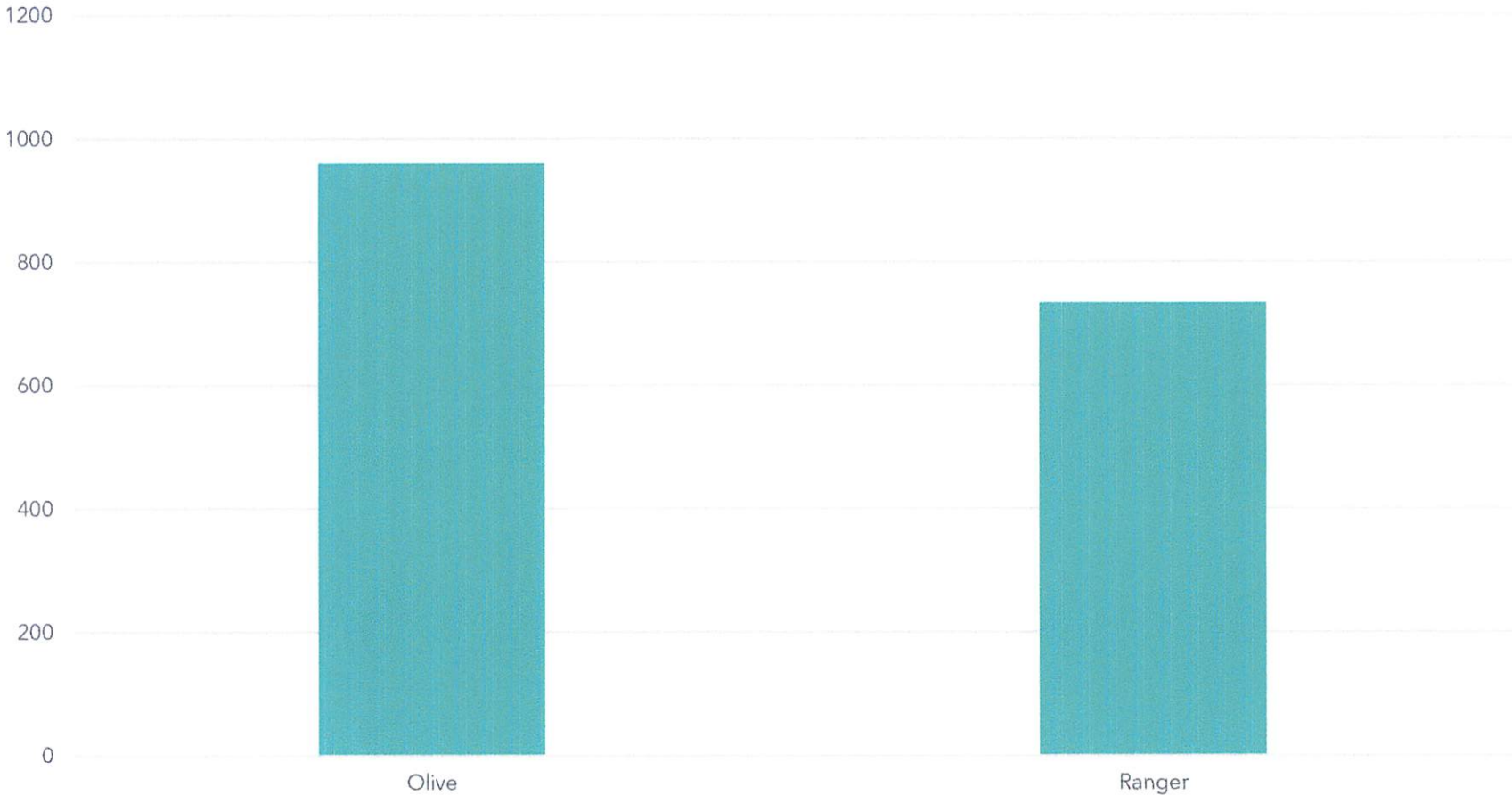

# FRANKLIN COUNTY RIDERSHIP BY FISCAL YEAR

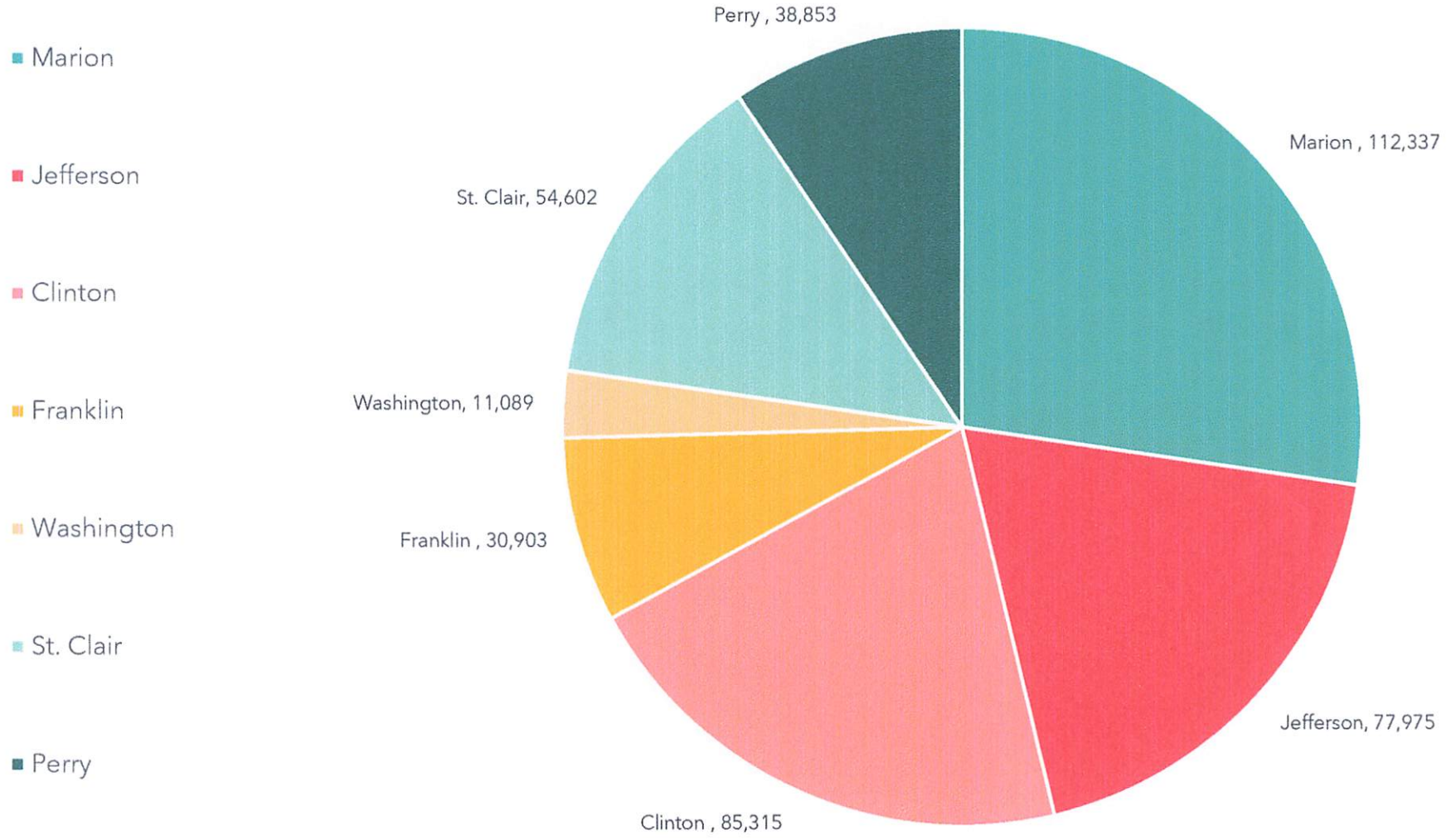


# FRANKLIN COUNTY SHUTTLE ROUTES

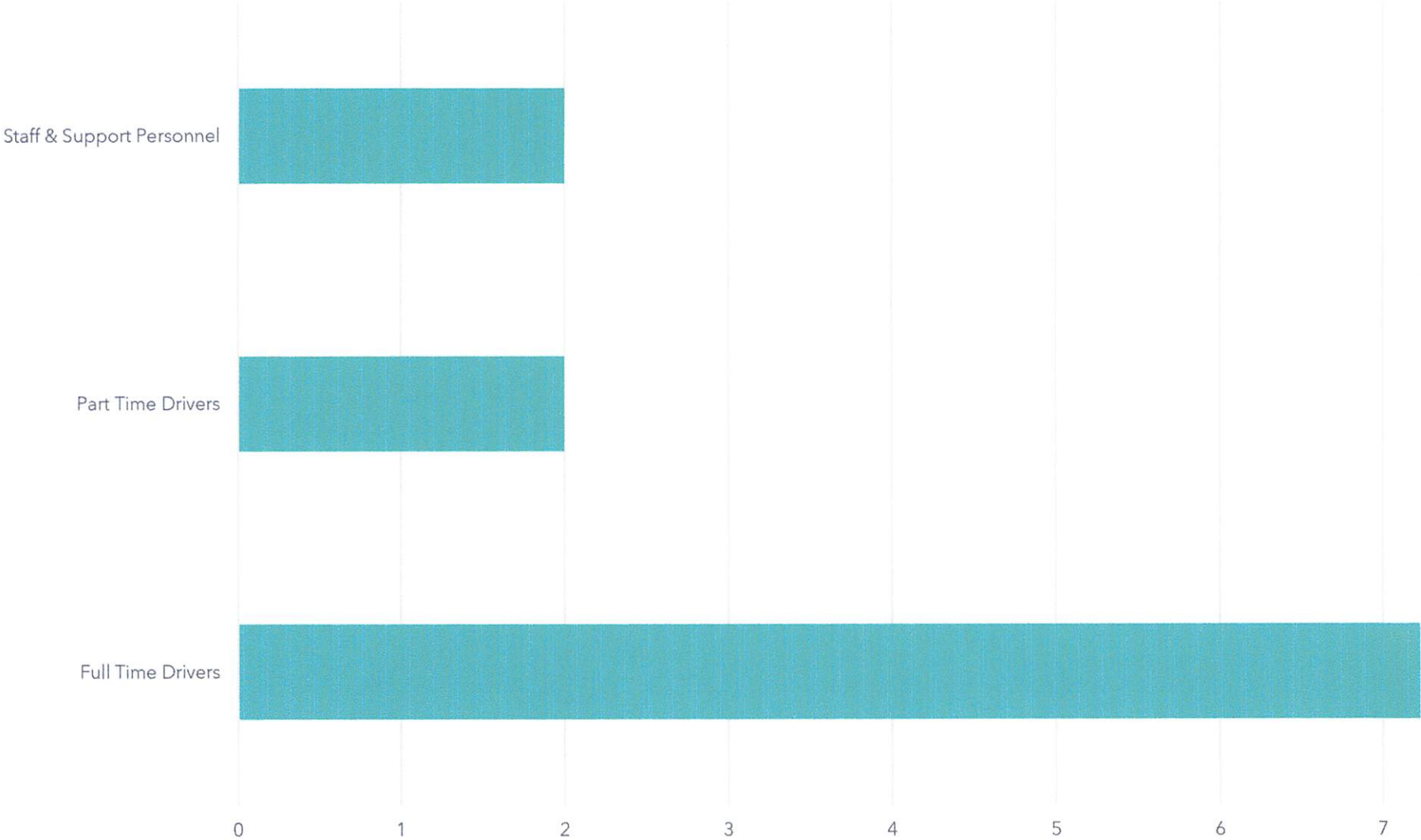
FRANKLIN COUNTY SHUTTLE ROUTES JUNE 2025
